Proceeding of the General Body Meeting of Indian Society for Sheep and Goat Production and Utilization held on 10th Nov. 2017 at CIRG, Makhdoom, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh

The general body meeting of ISSGPU was held under the chairmanship of Dr. M.S. Chauhan, President, ISSGPU & Director of CIRG, Makhdoom, Vice Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer, Executive members and life members of the ISSGPU Society.

Dr. Satish Kumar, Secretary ISSGPU extended the welcome of President, Vice-Presidents, Executive and life members of the ISSGPU Society. In the meeting, new and old agenda items were discussed. The financial status/expenditure of the ISSGPU society for the year 2016-17 was presented by Dr. Y.P. Gadekar, Treasurer, ISSGPU. The following agenda items were discussed and decisions were taken in the General body meeting.

6. The Editorial board of the ISSGPU Journal was revised as: Dr. A.K. Shinde (Editor), Dr. C.P. Swarnkar and Dr. A.K. Goel (Associate Editors); while Dr. N. Kandasamy, Dr. Raghvendra Singh, Dr. V.K. Gupta, Dr. A.K. Mishra, Dr. N.K.S. Gowda, Dr. N. Kondaiah, Dr. Shalander Kumar, Dr. M.K. Singh, Dr. Gohn Gauhan, and Dr. N. Shanmugam as Editorial Board members.
7. It was unanimously agreed to revise the monthly honorarium to ISSGPU office staff at Avikanagar from Rs. 1000/- to Rs. 1500/- (one thousand and five hundred only).
8. There was demand that certificate to the reviewers for reviewing the articles of the ISSGPU journal may be given or the name of the reviewer may be reflected on the last page of the journal (It will be decided by the Editor of the Journal for its suitability).
9. It was decided to honor one best/progressive sheep/goat farmer (who is a member of ISSGPU) at time of seminar/conference. He will be entitled to travel by III tier AC from hometown/farm to the venue of Seminar/Conference. Further, his registration fee will be waived off. However, sheep or goat farmer should send a brief written material/ paper outline about his achievements before commencement of seminar to Secretary, ISSGPU.
10. It was also agreed that, the registration fee should be waived-off from the retired personnel's who are the life member of ISSGPU.
6. The venue of the next seminar will be decided by the Society in a due course of time.
7. Proforma of application on ISSGPU Fellow Award needs to be revised. It should be on the basis of the contribution of the scientists to research and extension on small ruminants and contribution to the society only. The ISSGPU fellow must have at least 15 years as life membership and must have minimum 40 full research articles on sheep/goat or rabbit with 5.0 and above NAAS impact factor. The minimum age of the fellow should be 48 years as on 4th January of the preceding year (4th January of the year of seminar).

For evaluation of the fellow applications, proforma application (Publication, NASS, H-index/SCI impact factor, achievements and patent etc.) will be developed and utilized as criteria for selection of the fellow). The number of ISSGPU Fellow Award will be given maximum to **FOUR** only at one occasion/each seminar. A committee may decide to give less than four Fellow Award or may not to propose any award, if suitable application is not received). For selection of the ISSGPU fellow, the committee will constituted as follows:


- An eminent Scientist will act as Chairman of the committee
- One Member (Who is life member of ISSGPU and must have 8 years of research experience at the level of Principal Scientist from ICAR-CIRG, Makhdoom)
- One Member (Who is life member of ISSGPU and must have 8 years of research experience at the level of Principal Scientist from ICAR-CSWRI Avikanagar)
- One Member (Who is life member of ISSGPU and must have 8 years of research experience at the level of Principal Scientist/ Professor from any other Institute)
- Member Secretary – Secretary, ISSGPU

All application will be submitted to Secretary, ISSGPU. Applications will be screened by Secretary, ISSGPU regarding the eligibility and other terms and conditions. There is no application fee for ISSGPU Fellow. However, this criteria and above terms and conditions will not be applicable to the regular Director of CIRG/CSWRI who have completed three years of service in the Institute and the NGO, who is working on sheep or goat research, but such NGO must have at least 15 years of its establishment and must have visible contribution on sheep and goat production in India.

8. Young & Middle Career Scientist Award: The society has initiated Young Scientist Award up to the age of 35 years (as on 4th January of the year of seminar) in the year 2017. In the meeting, it was discussed to initiate Middle Career Scientist Award up to the age of 48 years (as on 4th Jan of the year of seminar) to motivate the middle career Scientists. However, the young and middle Career Scientist Awardee should have at least one year and ten years of ISSGPU life membership, respectively. All applications will be submitted to Secretary, ISSGPU in due course of time and these will be screened by Secretary, ISSGPU regarding their eligibility and terms and conditions. Proforma application/criteria will be developed for Young Scientist and Middle Career Scientist Award. For selection of the Young Scientist Award & Middle Career Scientist Award, a committee will be constituted for reviewing the applications of Young/Middle Career Scientists. However, constitution of the committee will be as under as:

- An eminent Scientist will act as Chairman of the committee
- One member (Who is life member of ISSGPU and must have 5 years of research experience at the level of Principal Scientist from ICAR-CIRG, Makhdoom)
- One Member (Who is life member of ISSGPU and must have 5 years of research experience at the level of Principal Scientist from ICAR-CSWRI Avikanagar)
- One Member (5 years of research experience at the level of Principal Scientist/Professor from any other Institute)
- Member Secretary - Secretary ISSGPU


The number of young and middle career scientist award will be given to ONE scientist only to each category per seminar. If suitable application is not received then society will not give any award during the year of seminar. The application along with the research contribution of the scientist will be reviewed and concerned scientist will be invited to present the research findings during the national seminar.


9. Life Time Achievement Award: It will be given to ONE senior most ISSGPU life member after two year of each seminar (a scientist who have devoted whole scientific carrier in the field of sheep and goat research). Eligibility and terms and condition will be same as the ISSGPU fellow. Committee constituted for ISSGPU fellow will propose / nominate the name of the Life Time Achievement awardee. However, the awardee will be entitled to travel to and fro journey with II AC train/economy class air fare from home town/office to the venue of seminar. There is no registration and accommodation fee for the awardee.


10. All awards will be invited with wide circulation though ISSGPU website and e-mailed to each life members of the society.

11. It is stated that the President and Secretary of ISSGPU Society will be signatory authorities in ISSGPU Fellow Award, Life Time Achievement Award, Young and Middle Career Scientist Awards, Best Research Paper Award Certificates. However, the President, Secretary and Organizing Secretary will be signatory authorities in Best Oral and Best Poster Presentation Award Certificates.


