

Indian Society for Sheep and Goat Production and Utilization (ISSGPU) invites you for its International conference, 2024 (ISSGPUCON 2024) on "Recent trends and future perspectives to improve the performance, health and welfare of small ruminants under changing climate scenario" to be organized by Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Veterinary Education and Research (RIVER) at Puducherry from April 24th to 26th, 2024.

Global livestock production is now under immense pressure for sustainability under the challenging climatic conditions. Climate change leads to reduction in livestock productivity by directly depressing animals' adaptive response mechanisms, altering the spread and prevalence of diseases. One step towards food security is to have species and breeds which can cope with adversities of climate change. In this aspect, there is an increasing preference among the small and marginal farmers of urban and semi urban areas for small ruminants especially the goat farming over large ruminants due to the perception about superior capacity to tolerate water and feed scarcity, heat stress, and for possessing better skills to adapt to the environment.

The sheep and goats play a significant role in the livelihood and nutritional security of a large number of rural farmers. The theme of this conference aims to highlight recent innovative technologies and the perspectives in the field of climate resilient small ruminant production to augment performance, health and welfare. To focus on the above aspects, significant number of eminent academicians, scientists, students, policy makers from India and abroad are likely to grace the event.





Mout Puducherry







The Union Territory of Puducherry comprises the former French establishments of Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam, which lie scattered in South India. Puducherry, the capital of the Territory was once the original headquarters of the French in India, is situated on the Coromandel Coast of the Bay of Bengal and is about 135 kms. from Chennai airport. It is bounded on the east by the Bay of Bengal and on the three sides by land. All the regions of Puducherry were under the French rule for 138 years. On November 1, 1954, the French possessions in India were de facto transferred to the Indian Union and became a Union Territory. But only in 1963, Puducherry became officially an integral part of India.

Puducherry is a peaceful city. It is referred by names such as 'Quintessence of French Culture', 'India's Little France' and 'The French Riviera of the East'. Still, it has the French flavor in it as one can see by the grand colonial mansions, beautiful boulevards, and placid promenades, spellings on sign boards and buildings, names of roads and public places.

The uniqueness of Puducherry town invariably lies in skilful town planning and Franco Tamil architecture. The Union Territory with legislature extends over an area of 479 Sq. Kms. Total population of the Union Territory is 12,44,464 with a literacy rate of 86.55%.





Mout Host Institute

Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Veterinary Education and Research (RIVER) is fully funded

by the Government of Puducherry and affiliated to the Pondicherry University and established as per VCI regulations. Since its inception in 1994, the institute has made spectacular progress owing to the excellent support extended by the Government of Puducherry.

Abstract should be submitted by email to **issgpu2024@river.edu.in** on or before **15.03.2024**. The abstracts will be screened and the acceptance will be intimated. The presenting author should be registered for the conference and the number of abstracts per presenting author is limited to two.
